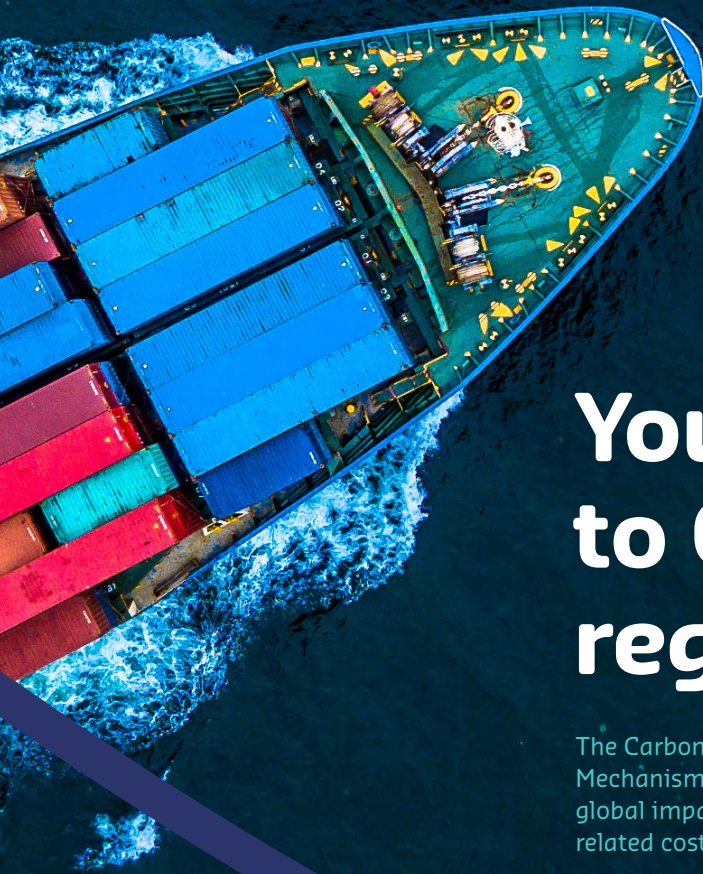

Your guide to CBAM regulation

The Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM) is an EU policy, with global impact, that charges climate-related costs to imported goods.

CBAM is the EU's tool to set a fair price on the CO₂ emitted during the production of carbon-intensive goods entering EU borders. It aims to encourage cleaner industrial production in non-EU countries.

From 1st Jan 2026, EU importers will need to purchase CBAM certificates to compensate the emissions of the goods they import.







What do you need to be CBAM compliant?

As an importer of goods, you must report the embedded emissions of your imports, based on actual values.

As a producer of goods (manufacturer) any products you export to the EU market must come with a CBAM compliant carbon footprint calculation (based on actual values).

As of 1st Jan 2025, the CBAM carbon footprint only accepts the EU method for its calculation.
